Safe Baby trainings are provided by the Healthy Start Coalition of Hillsborough County to prepare professionals to teach families how to prevent infant deaths by educating them on how to choose a safe caregiver, prevent Shaken Baby Syndrome and follow safe sleep practices as recommended by the American Academy of Pediatrics. Participants will also learn about the dangers of distracted parenting.
